

Body Image and Sexuality in Women Treated for Cancer

Treatment for cancer can change a woman's life in many different ways and many women have concerns or questions during/after treatment. One of the changes many women have is with their body image and sexuality. If you are noticing any of the changes listed below, help and support is available to you:

- Changes in body image or how you see yourself as a woman
- Changes in physical or emotional feelings related to sexuality or sexual activity
- Sexual pain (pain with sexual touch or sexual activity)
- Concerns about the relationship(s) with your partner(s)
- Concerns about dating and/or sexual activity/touch
- Questions about having children in the future
