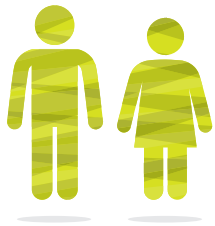

Alternative Isolation Accommodation Outside Of Home Community For Indigenous People Who Are COVID-19 Positive And Their Close Contacts

WHO?



An Indigenous person who is outside of their home community when tested positive for COVID-19.

Close contacts of COVID-19 positive person who are outside of their home community.



WHAT?

Person requires accommodation, meals, support and follow-up for isolation outside of home community because they do not have an acceptable location to self-isolate. If home care support is required, this can be arranged.



SUPPORT

Prior to being discharged or when medical care is finished, talk to the public health nurse who has contacted you regarding Alternative Isolation Accommodation for self isolation.

*** If you were out of your community for non-medical reasons (e.g. work-related travel, meetings, vacation) when the community went into lock-down, contact your community leadership and/or health director to confirm what you should do to self-isolate prior to returning home.**
