

How to access your COVID-19 test results

Timelines for COVID-19 test results may vary due to current testing volumes and the location where you were tested. It may take several days for your COVID-19 test results to become available.

Individuals who test positive for COVID-19 will be immediately contacted by Public Health. Health-care workers will be contacted by Occupational Health.

Once available, negative results may be accessed in either of the following two ways:

1. A secure online portal

To obtain your results online, visit <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/test-results/>.

Step 1 - Select Register New User

Step 2 - Choose and enter a unique user name (the system will identify if your chosen user name is already taken)

Step 3 - Enter a password

Step 4 - You will be prompted to enter information directly from your Manitoba Health Registration Card, which includes your first and last name (1), personal health information number (PHIN) (2), the Registration Number (3), and date of birth (4). When you set up your account, please ensure your first and last name and other identifying information is entered **EXACTLY** as it appears on your Manitoba Health Card

Step 5 - Enter your email address and telephone number

Step 6 - Accept the Terms of Use

Step 7 - You will receive a notification to the email address you have provided. Click on the link to complete the creation of your account.

If required, you can print a copy of your results from the portal.

If you do not have a Manitoba Health Registration Card, are not a resident of Manitoba, or you are unable to access your negative test results online, call the COVID Line at Health Links - Info Santé at (204)788-8200 or toll-free at 1-888-315-9257.

2. Results by phone

Negative COVID-19 results are also available by phone 24/7. Call the COVID Line at Health Links - Info Santé at (204)788-8200 or toll-free at 1-888-315-9257.
