Language Interpreter Services Available Quick Reference Guide for Provincial COVID-19 Testing Sites



To reduce the risks associated with language barriers, WRHA employs or contracts with trained, accredited interpreters who provide services in many languages.

If there is an urgent need for staff at provincial COVID-19 testing sites to access over-the-phone interpreter services, **call WRHA Language Access to be routed** to the department/agency responsible for the language constituency required if interpretation services are not available in your region:

- Cree, Oji-Cree and Ojibway language interpretation by WRHA Indigenous Health
- Inuktitut language interpretation by Kivalliq Inuit Services
- American Sign Language interpretation by ECCOE
- Over 200 languages interpreted by WRHA Language Access

Language Interpreter Service Overview:

- WRHA Language Interpreter Services are available 24/7 in-person, over-the-phone, via MBTelehealth or video conference.
- WRHA Language services are provided at no cost to publicly funded health services such as hospitals, community health services, CancerCare MB, Health Links/Info Santé and fee-for-service physicians working in the Winnipeg Health Region. Services are accessible on a cost-recovery basis by government services, privately funded health services, other Manitoba regional health authorities, and other organizations.
